Boneita A. Miller, 84, of Gratz, passed away on February 7, 2023, at Northern Dauphin Nursing & Rehab Center, Millersburg. She was born in Malta on November 17, 1938, a daughter of the late Helen and Charles Long. Boneita retired from the Postal Service in 1992 as the Gratz Postmaster.

She was a member of St Peter's UCC, Lykens Township, former organist of Peace UCC and Simeon United Lutheran Church. She was a member of the Senior Choir and former Sunday School Teacher, a member of the Willing Workers and on the formation committee of the Gratz Area Ambulance Club and served as secretary for several years, a member of the Gratz VFW Auxiliary, Gratz Fire Co. and Gratz Historical Society.
