Curtis L. Grimm, 92, of Herndon, passed away on June 2, 2013, peacefully, at the Manor at Susquehanna Village, Millersburg. He was born in Northumberland, PA on October 26, 1920, a son of the late Kate (Walt) Grimm and the late Allen L. Grimm.

Curtis was employed as a Design Technician for CBS Construction for 40 years. He was the husband of Evelyn (Shaffer) "Polly" Grimm, married for 66 years on Christmas Eve. Curtis served in the Army during World War II, in Alaska and the Aleutian Islands in the 131st Signal Radio Intelligence Company.
