Randall L. Klinger, 67, of Herndon, passed away on October 27, 2015, at the Geisinger Medical Center, Danville. He was born in Sunbury on October 24, 1948, a son of Marjorie and the late Lee Klinger. Randall was employed as a Loan Officer for Gratz Bank and retired from Mid Penn Bank after 40 years of service. He served in the United States Army. 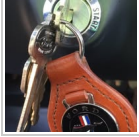
