Regina E. Heiliger, 93, of Millersburg, passed away on November 27, 2022, at the Northern Dauphin Nursing and Rehab, Millersburg. She was born in Lower Mahanoy Twp on October 15, 1929, a daughter of the late Helen (Latsha) and Albert Lenker. She was married to the late Darrell W. Heiliger for 46 years.

Regina, was a graduate of the Lower Mahanoy Township High School in 1947. She had been employed by the Commonwealth Telephone Co. and the Schaffers Garage, in Millersburg and was an Avon Representative for many years.

Regina was a member of the St. Paul Lutheran Church in Millersburg and an alternate member of the Trinity County Line United Methodist Church, RD Dalmatia. She was an active choir member in both churches.

Active in civic organizations, Regina was on the board of directors of the Mahanoy and Mahantango Historical and Preservation Society and chaired the Ways and Means Committee. A volunteer worker at the Susquehanna Lutheran Village in Millersburg for many years, she was also a board member of the Order of the Good Shephard.

She was a co-founder of the County Line Picnic Association, she served as its president for 20 years following its inception. A music lover, she sang in

various local choruses, and was interested in perpetuating PA German music. She exhibited home preserved products at various fairs including the PA Farm Show and enjoyed growing roses and gardening.
