



## Ronald Romberger

November 20, 1943 - June 7, 2017

Ronald E. Romberger, 73, of Pillow, passed away on June 7, 2017, at his residence. He was born in Millersburg on November 20, 1943, a son of the late Susan and Marlin Romberger. Ronald was employed as a Accountant for American Can Co/Silgan Can Co in Lemoyne, PA, Puerto Rico, Chicago, IL, Grand Prairie, TX, Kansas City MO, and Paris, TX.

He served in the Air Force during Vietnam War as an air traffic controler. He was a 1961 graduate of Millersburg High School, graduated from HACCC in 1967 and attended Upper Iowa University for accounting.
