T. Dean Witmer, 91, of Camp Hill, PA entered into his heavenly home on Monday, July 31, 2017. Born in Malta, PA on March 16, 1926. He was the son of Clarence and Stella Martz Witmer.

He graduated from Lower Mahanoy Twp High School, now part of Line Mountain School District. Dean attended Penn State for one year and then enlisted in the US Navy and served from 1944 to 1946. He then went back to Penn State receiving his BS Degree in 49, MEd in 55 and DEd in 71.

While at PSU he played Soccer 43-46 and was Captain in 48. After graduating he taught Agriculture in Loyalsock Joint, Forksville, Snyder and Northumberland, PA. He was a Vocational Ag Supervisor and Future Farmer of America Advisor Sun Area from 53-64. Asst. State Ag ED Supervisor 64-71, Special Voc Section Chief-71-75, Voc Curriculum Dev. Div. Chief 75-80, Voc Field Consultant York & Adams County 81-85 and retired in 1985.

During his life time, Dean was active in coaching and playing Baseball, Gideon International, Free Mason, teaching Sunday School in his Church, Volunteering for Heifer Project Int., Harrisburg Food Pantry and Meals on Wheels.

Dean is survived by his beloved wife Barbara Brown Witmer, son Christopher,

Adam Brown (wife Andrea), two grandchildren Addison and Adam Danger Brown, daughter Suzanne Brown, daughter-in-law Lynn, adopted grandson David Krickmar, sister Ethel, brothers Nels, Carl & Kermit and many loved nieces and nephews.
