Warren G. Wolfe, 89, of Gratz, passed away on January 7, 2015, at the The Manor at Penn Village, Selinsgrove. He was born in Spring Glen on April 6, 1925, a son of the late Mary Wolfe and the late Jacob Wolfe.

Warren was employed as a Truck Driver for the former Agway and served in the U.S. Army during WWII, wounded during the Battle of the Bulge. He was the husband of Emma Straub Wolfe, who preceded him in death on January 20, 2001. He was a member of Zion Klingers Lutheran Church, Erdman Sportsman's Association, Mason Lodge 702, Herndon, and the Diamond Jubilee VFW post 2385, Gratz.

Warren is survived by one son Robert and wife Tamie Wolfe of Selinsgrove, three grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by several brothers and sisters.
